Finding the Furry Cat!

Discovering the Furry Cat through Fun Math!

DEFINITION

Finding the furry cat involves solving simple math problems to locate it. It helps students practice addition and subtraction in a playful way.

KEY CONCEPTS

Addition Basics

Addition means putting together two or more numbers to find a total.

Subtraction Basics

Subtraction involves taking one number away from another to find the difference.

Counting Skills

Counting is the ability to recognize and list numbers in order.

Problem Solving

Problem solving is figuring out how to answer questions or complete tasks using math.

Visual Aids

Using pictures or objects can help understand math problems better.

EXAMPLES

- If there are 3 cats and 2 more come, how many cats are there now?
- There are 5 fish, and 2 swim away. How many are left?
- Count the number of cats in the picture and add 1 more.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'add' means to put together, like adding toppings on a pizza.
- ★ Think of subtraction as taking away, like sharing your toys.
- ★ Use your fingers to count when you're unsure of numbers.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Mixing up addition and subtraction signs.
- ✗ Counting objects incorrectly.
- ✗ Not reading the problem carefully before solving.

QUICK RECAP
