Understanding Business: Its Nature and Purpose

DEFINITION

Business refers to organized efforts to provide goods and services to meet consumer needs. Its primary purpose is to generate profit while fulfilling societal demands.

KEY CONCEPTS

Goods and Services

Goods are tangible products, while services are intangible offerings that satisfy customer needs.

Profit Motive

The main goal of business is to earn profit, which incentivizes innovation and efficiency.

Social Responsibility

Businesses have a duty to contribute positively to society and consider their impact on the community.

Risk and Uncertainty

Business involves taking risks and facing uncertainties, which can affect profitability and sustainability.

Market Demand

Understanding market demand is crucial for businesses to align their products and services with consumer preferences.
