DEFINITION

English is a language used for communication, consisting of words, sentences, and grammar rules. In Class 3, students learn to read, write, and understand English better.

KEY CONCEPTS

Nouns

Nouns are words that name people, places, things, or ideas, like 'dog' or 'school'.

Verbs

Verbs are action words that tell what someone or something does, such as 'run' or 'jump'.

Adjectives

Adjectives describe nouns, giving more information about them, like 'happy' or 'blue'.

Sentences

A sentence is a group of words that expresses a complete thought, like 'The cat sleeps.'

Punctuation

Punctuation marks, like periods and commas, help clarify meaning in sentences.

EXAMPLES

- The dog barks loudly.
- She is a kind girl.
- They play in the park.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'Nouns are names' to recall what nouns are.
- ★ Use 'Verbs are actions' to remember the role of verbs.
- ★ Think 'Adjectives add detail' to recall what adjectives do.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing nouns with verbs.
- ✗ Omitting punctuation at the end of sentences.
- ✗ Using adjectives incorrectly, like saying 'the run dog' instead of 'the running dog'.
