DEFINITION

Science is the study of the natural world through observation and experimentation. It helps us understand how things work and the principles behind them.

KEY CONCEPTS

Scientific Method

A systematic process for investigating questions and solving problems through observation and experimentation.

Energy

The ability to do work or cause change, existing in various forms like heat, light, and motion.

Forces

Pushes or pulls that can change the motion of an object, such as gravity and friction.

Matter

Anything that has mass and takes up space, including solids, liquids, and gases.

Ecosystems

Communities of living organisms interacting with their environment, including plants, animals, and microorganisms.

EXAMPLES

- Mixing vinegar and baking soda to create a chemical reaction.
- Observing plants growing towards sunlight.
- Measuring the temperature of water in different states.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'SIMPLE' for the Scientific Method: State, Investigate, Measure, Predict, Learn, Evaluate.
- ★ Use 'M.E.F.' to recall Matter, Energy, and Forces.
- ★ Think of 'ECO' for Ecosystems: Energy, Communities, Organisms.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing mass with weight.
- ✗ Ignoring the importance of controlled experiments.
- ✗ Overlooking the role of variables in experiments.
