DEFINITION

Mathematics in NDA/NA exams tests candidates' problem-solving and analytical skills through various topics. A strong grasp of these concepts is essential for success.

KEY CONCEPTS

Algebra

Involves solving equations and understanding variables, functions, and inequalities.

Geometry

Focuses on properties and relations of points, lines, surfaces, and solids.

Trigonometry

Studies the relationships between the angles and sides of triangles.

Statistics

Involves collecting, analyzing, and interpreting data to make informed decisions.

Arithmetic

Covers basic operations like addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.

EXAMPLES

- Solve for x in $2x + 3 = 11$.
- Calculate the area of a triangle with base 5 and height 10.
- Find the sine of a 30-degree angle.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember SOHCAHTOA for trigonometric ratios: Sine = Opposite/Hypotenuse.
- ★ Use the acronym PEMDAS for order of operations: Parentheses, Exponents, Multiplication, Division, Addition, Subtraction.
- ★ Visualize geometric shapes to recall their properties and formulas.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to check units in word problems.
- ✗ Misapplying formulas in geometry and trigonometry.
- ✗ Rushing through calculations, leading to simple arithmetic errors.
