KEY CONCEPTS

Kinematics

The study of motion, including concepts like velocity, acceleration, and displacement.

Work and Energy

Work is the energy transferred when a force acts over a distance; energy can be kinetic or potential.

Waves and Sound

Waves transfer energy through mediums; sound is a mechanical wave that requires a medium to travel.

Optics

The study of light behavior, including reflection, refraction, and lens applications.

Thermodynamics

The branch of physics that deals with heat, work, and energy transformations.

EXAMPLES

- Calculating the trajectory of a projectile.
- Determining the energy of a moving object.
- Analyzing the frequency of a sound wave.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Use ' $V = u + at$ ' to remember the basic kinematic equation.
- ★ Remember ' $PE = mgh$ ' for potential energy (mass x gravity x height).
- ★ For optics, think ' $\frac{1}{f} = \frac{1}{d_o} + \frac{1}{d_i}$ ' for lens formulas.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing units of measurement, like joules and newtons.
- ✗ Neglecting to account for friction in energy problems.
- ✗ Overlooking the direction of vectors in kinematics.
