DEFINITION

- ★ Use 'Blade' like a 'Blade of a knife' for cutting through complex HTML.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to run migrations after creating database tables.
- ✗ Forgetting to include namespaces in controllers.
- ✗ Misconfiguring environment variables in the .env file.
