DEFINITION

Cross platform testing ensures software works consistently across different devices and operating systems. It helps identify issues that may arise due to platform differences.

KEY CONCEPTS

Device Compatibility

Testing how applications perform on various devices ensures they function correctly for all users.

Operating System Variability

Different operating systems can affect application behavior; testing helps catch these discrepancies.

Automated Testing Tools

Tools like Selenium and Appium can automate tests across platforms, saving time and effort.

User Interface Consistency

Ensuring the UI looks and behaves similarly across platforms enhances user satisfaction.

Performance Testing

Evaluating how well an application performs under various conditions is crucial for user retention.

EXAMPLES

- Testing a mobile app on both iOS and Android devices.
- Using Selenium to run automated tests on a web application across different browsers.
- Checking a game’s performance on both PC and console platforms.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Think 'D.O.U.P.' for Device, OS, UI, Performance.
- ★ Remember 'A.C.E.' for Automated tools, Compatibility, and End-user experience.
- ★ Visualize a crossroad where all platforms meet to recall testing focus.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to test on less popular devices or OS versions.
- ✗ Overlooking performance issues that only appear on specific platforms.
- ✗ Assuming a single test is sufficient for all platforms.
