DEFINITION

Expo is an open-source platform that helps developers build cross-platform mobile applications using React Native. It provides tools and services to streamline the development process.

KEY CONCEPTS

Managed Workflow

Bare Workflow

The bare workflow gives developers full control over native code, allowing for custom native modules.

Expo Go
