Introduction to Mobile CI/CD

Streamline Mobile App Development with CI/CD Practices

DEFINITION

Mobile CI/CD refers to Continuous Integration and Continuous Deployment processes tailored for mobile applications. It automates testing and deployment, ensuring faster and more reliable app updates.

KEY CONCEPTS

Continuous Integration

A practice where developers frequently integrate code changes into a shared repository, allowing for early detection of issues.

Automated Testing

Using scripts to run tests automatically, ensuring that new code does not break existing functionality.

Version Control

A system that records changes to files over time, allowing developers to track and manage code revisions.

Continuous Deployment

An extension of CI that automatically deploys code changes to production after passing tests, ensuring users get updates quickly.

Build Pipeline

A series of automated processes that code changes go through, from integration to deployment.

EXAMPLES

- Using Jenkins for automated builds and tests.
- Deploying updates to the App Store via Fastlane.
- Integrating Firebase for real-time crash reporting.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember CI as 'Code Integration' and CD as 'Code Deployment'.
- ★ Think of a pipeline as a water flow: smooth and continuous.
- ★ Use the acronym BAT (Build, Automate, Test) to recall key CI/CD steps.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to write automated tests before deployment.
- ✗ Skipping version control, leading to code conflicts.
- ✗ Overlooking environment configurations, causing deployment failures.
