DEFINITION

- ★ Think of HTML5 as 'HTML for the 21st Century' to recall its modern features.
- ★ Use 'F.A.C.E.' to remember Form enhancements, APIs, Canvas, and Elements.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to use semantic elements for better SEO.
- ✗ Forgetting to include fallback options for unsupported features.
- ✗ Overusing `<div>` instead of appropriate semantic elements.
