- ★ Think 'C' for Control Structures as they 'Control' the flow of your code.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Forgetting to declare variables with 'let', 'const', or 'var'.
- ✗ Using incorrect syntax for functions or missing parentheses.
- ✗ Not understanding the difference between '==' and '===' in comparisons.
