DEFINITION

App builders are tools that allow users to create applications without extensive coding knowledge. They simplify the development process, making it accessible to non-programmers.

KEY CONCEPTS

Low Code

No Code

No code platforms enable users to create apps entirely through visual interfaces without writing code.

- ✗ Overcomplicating designs instead of using simple templates.
- ✗ Neglecting to test integrations with other services before deployment.
- ✗ Assuming no code means no learning; understanding the platform is still essential.
