- ★ Think of 'OOP' as 'Objects Organize Programs' to recall object-oriented programming.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Forgetting to include necessary headers like `<iostream>`.
- ✗ Confusing assignment '=' with equality '==' in conditions.
- ✗ Neglecting to use proper syntax for loops and conditionals.
