DEFINITION

JavaScript is a versatile programming language primarily used for creating dynamic web content. It allows developers to implement complex features on web pages.

KEY CONCEPTS

Variables

Events

Conditional Statements

Conditional statements allow the code to make decisions based on certain conditions, enabling different outcomes.

EXAMPLES

```
→ let name = 'Alice';  
→ function greet() { console.log('Hello!'); }  
→  
document.getElementById('myElement').innerHTML  
= 'New Content';
```

- ★ Remember 'JavaScript' as 'Just Simple Programming' for its ease of use.
- ★ Think of 'DOM' as 'Document's Organizing Model' to recall its purpose.
- ★ Use 'FIVE' for Functions, If statements, Variables, Events to remember key concepts.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Forgetting to end statements with a semicolon.
- ✗ Using the wrong data type in operations.
- ✗ Not properly referencing DOM elements.
