DEFINITION

Portfolio management is the centralized management of one or more portfolios to achieve strategic objectives. It involves prioritizing projects and allocating resources effectively.

KEY CONCEPTS

Portfolio Definition

A portfolio is a collection of projects and programs managed together to achieve strategic goals.

Strategic Alignment

Ensuring that all projects within a portfolio align with the organization's overall strategy and objectives.

Resource Allocation

Distributing resources such as time, money, and personnel across projects to maximize efficiency and effectiveness.

Risk Management

Identifying, assessing, and prioritizing risks across the portfolio to minimize negative impacts on projects.

Performance Measurement

Evaluating the success of projects and overall portfolio performance using key performance indicators (KPIs).

EXAMPLES

- A company prioritizes a software upgrade project over a marketing campaign to enhance customer experience.
- A project manager reallocates team members from a low-priority project to a high-impact initiative.
- A firm assesses the risks of launching multiple new products simultaneously to avoid resource strain.

- ★ Remember 'PARS' for Portfolio Management: Projects, Alignment, Resources, Strategy.
- ★ Use the acronym 'RAMP' to recall key concepts: Risk, Allocation, Measurement, Performance.
- ★ Visualize a pie chart representing different projects within a portfolio to grasp resource distribution.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to align projects with strategic goals.
- ✗ Failing to regularly review and adjust portfolio performance.
- ✗ Overcommitting resources without assessing project priorities.
