DEFINITION

Cypress is a modern testing framework designed for automating web applications. It allows developers to write tests easily and run them in real-time.

KEY CONCEPTS

End-to-End Testing

Cypress enables testing the entire application flow from start to finish, ensuring everything works together.

Time Travel

Cypress allows you to go back in time to see what happened at each step of your test.

Easy Debugging

Cypress provides detailed error messages and stack traces, making it easier to identify and fix issues.

Real-Time Reloads

Cypress automatically reloads tests in the browser as you make changes, speeding up the development process.

Automatic Waiting

Cypress waits for elements to appear and actions to complete, reducing the need for manual waits.

→ cy.get('button').click()
→
cy.contains('Welcome').should('be.visible')
```

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Think of Cypress as a 'cyber' assistant for testing your web apps.
- ★ Remember 'Time Travel' to visualize your test steps like a video replay.
- ★ Use 'Automatic Waiting' to avoid frustration with timing issues in tests.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to check for element visibility before interacting.
- ✗ Forgetting to use the correct selectors, leading to test failures.
- ✗ Overlooking the importance of clean test data for consistent results.
