DEFINITION

KEY CONCEPTS

Personal Information

Privacy Settings

These are tools that help control who can see your online information. Always adjust them to keep your data safe.

Cyberbullying

This is when someone uses technology to hurt or intimidate others. Report any bullying to an adult.

Secure Passwords

A strong password is hard to guess and should include letters, numbers, and symbols. Change it regularly.

Phishing Scams

These are fake messages that try to trick you into giving away personal information. Always verify before clicking links.

EXAMPLES

- Using a strong password like 'P@ssw0rd123!'
- Adjusting your social media privacy settings to 'Friends Only'
- Reporting a mean comment to a teacher

- ★ Remember 'PPS' for Personal info, Privacy settings, and Secure passwords.
- ★ Think of 'CPS' for Cyberbullying, Phishing scams, and Safety.
- ★ Use the phrase 'Stay Smart, Stay Safe' to recall key safety practices.

- ✗ Sharing personal information with strangers online.
- ✗ Using the same password for multiple accounts.
- ✗ Ignoring privacy settings on social media.
