KEY CONCEPTS

Observation Skills

Proportions

Understanding the size relationships between different parts of an object is crucial for realistic drawing.

Shading Techniques

Using light and dark areas creates depth and makes objects appear three-dimensional.

Line Quality

Different types of lines can convey texture and form, enhancing the overall drawing.

Composition

Arranging objects in a pleasing way on the page can make your drawing more interesting.

EXAMPLES

- Draw a simple apple using basic shapes.
- Sketch a chair focusing on its proportions and angles.
- Create a still life with fruits and vegetables.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'O.P.E.N' for Observation, Proportions, Edges, and Nature.
- ★ Think of 'S.L.I.C.E.' for Shading, Line quality, Interest, Composition, and Edges.
- ★ Visualize drawing as a puzzle where each piece fits together.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Ignoring proportions, leading to unrealistic drawings.
- ✗ Rushing through shading, resulting in flat images.
- ✗ Neglecting to observe details, making drawings less accurate.
