DEFINITION

KEY CONCEPTS

Sovereignty

A country has the right to govern itself without outside interference.

Borders

Countries are separated by borders, which can be natural or man-made.

Capital City

Each country has a capital city, where the government is located.

Population

The number of people living in a country can vary widely.

Culture

Countries have unique customs, traditions, and languages that define their identity.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing countries with states or provinces.
- ✗ Assuming all countries speak one language.
- ✗ Not recognizing that countries can have multiple capitals.
