DEFINITION

Countries are distinct areas of land governed by their own laws and leaders. They have unique cultures, languages, and histories.

KEY CONCEPTS

Sovereignty

A country has the right to govern itself without outside interference.

Capital City

Each country has a capital city where the government is located.

Population

The number of people living in a country can vary widely.

Borders

Countries are separated by borders that define their territory.

Culture

Countries have unique traditions, languages, and customs that shape their identity.

EXAMPLES

- France is known for its art and cuisine.
- Japan has a rich history and advanced technology.
- Brazil is famous for its carnival and rainforests.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'C' for Countries: Capital, Culture, and Citizens.
- ★ Use the acronym 'B.C.P.' for Borders, Capital, Population.
- ★ Visualize a globe to remember countries' locations.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing countries with cities or states.
- ✗ Assuming all countries speak one language.
- ✗ Not recognizing that some countries are landlocked.
