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What is Directions

Understanding Directions: Your Guide to Navigating the World!

DEFINITION

Directions tell us where to go and how to get there. They help us understand locations and navigate our surroundings.

KEY CONCEPTS

Cardinal Directions

These are the main directions: North, South, East, and West. They help us identify where to go.

Intermediate Directions

These are the directions between the cardinal points: Northeast, Southeast, Northwest, and Southwest.

Compass Rose

A compass rose is a diagram that shows the cardinal and intermediate directions on a map.

Landmarks

Landmarks are recognizable features in the environment that help us find our way.

Maps

Maps are visual representations of areas that show directions, landmarks, and distances.

EXAMPLES

- Turn left at the park to find the library.
- Go straight for two blocks, then right at the school.
- The store is northeast of the playground.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'Never Eat Soggy Waffles' for North, East, South, West.
- ★ Use a map to visualize directions and practice finding your way.
- ★ Think of a compass as a clock to remember directions.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing left and right when giving directions.
- ✗ Mixing up cardinal and intermediate directions.
- ✗ Not using landmarks to help remember routes.
