Protect Yourself: Master Password Safety!

DEFINITION

Password safety means creating and managing your passwords to keep your accounts secure. Strong passwords help prevent unauthorized access to your personal information.

KEY CONCEPTS

Strong Passwords

A strong password is at least 12 characters long, includes letters, numbers, and symbols.

Unique Passwords

Using different passwords for each account prevents a single breach from compromising multiple accounts.

Password Managers

Password managers securely store and generate complex passwords, making it easier to manage them.

Two-Factor Authentication

This adds an extra layer of security by requiring a second form of verification, like a text message.

Regular Updates

Changing your passwords regularly helps protect your accounts from potential threats.

EXAMPLES

- Use 'P@ssw0rd123!' instead of 'password'.
- Change your passwords every 3-6 months.
- Enable two-factor authentication on your email.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Think of a phrase and use the first letter of each word.
- ★ Combine unrelated words to create a unique password.
- ★ Use a song lyric and modify it with numbers and symbols.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Using easily guessable passwords like '123456'.
- ✗ Reusing the same password across multiple sites.
- ✗ Neglecting to enable two-factor authentication.
