Learn to Spot Safe Websites for Kids!

DEFINITION

Safe websites are online places where kids can explore without risks. They protect personal information and provide age-appropriate content.

KEY CONCEPTS

Secure Connection

Look for 'https://' in the website address, indicating a secure connection.

Age-Appropriate Content

Websites should have content suitable for your age group, avoiding harmful material.

Privacy Settings

Safe websites have clear privacy policies that explain how your information is used.

Trusted Sources

Use websites from known organizations, schools, or educational platforms.

No Personal Info

Never share personal details like your name, address, or phone number on websites.

EXAMPLES

- PBS Kids is a safe site for learning games.
- National Geographic Kids offers educational articles and videos.
- Scholastic provides age-appropriate books and activities.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'HTTPS' as 'Happy To Protect Securely'.
- ★ Think 'KIDS' for Knowledge, Information, Digital Safety.
- ★ Use the '3 P's': Protect, Privacy, and Permission.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Assuming all popular sites are safe.
- ✗ Not checking for secure connections.
- ✗ Sharing personal information on interactive sites.
