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# What is Pattern Recognition

DEFINITION

Pattern recognition is identifying regularities and trends in numbers or shapes. It helps us predict what comes next in a sequence.

KEY CONCEPTS

**Sequences**

A sequence is an ordered list of numbers or shapes that follow a specific rule.

**Repetition**

Repetition involves recognizing the same elements appearing multiple times in a pattern.

**Symmetry**

Symmetry is when one side of a shape mirrors the other, creating balance.

**Patterns in Nature**

Many patterns occur in nature, like the arrangement of leaves or the stripes on a zebra.

**Predicting Outcomes**

By recognizing patterns, we can predict what comes next in a series or situation.

EXAMPLES

- 1, 2, 3, 4, ... (adding 1 each time)
- Red, blue, red, blue, ... (alternating colors)
- Circle, square, circle, square, ... (repeating shapes)

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Use the phrase 'See the pattern!' to remind yourself to look for trends.
- ★ Draw shapes or colors to visualize patterns.
- ★ Create a song or rhyme using numbers to remember sequences.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Forgetting to look for both numbers and shapes.
- ✗ Assuming patterns always increase or decrease without checking.
- ✗ Overlooking simple patterns in complex sequences.
