DEFINITION

Poster making is the art of creating visual displays to convey messages or ideas. It combines images, text, and design to attract attention and communicate effectively.

KEY CONCEPTS

Design Layout

The arrangement of images and text on the poster for clear communication.

Color Theory

Typography

The style and appearance of text, which affects readability and impact.

Target Audience

Identifying who the poster is for helps tailor the message and design.

Visual Hierarchy

Organizing elements to guide the viewer's attention in a specific order.

EXAMPLES

- An educational poster about recycling featuring images and statistics.
- A motivational poster with an inspiring quote and vibrant background.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'D-C-T-V' for Design, Color, Typography, and Visual hierarchy.
- ★ Think of posters as 'P-I-C-T-U-R-E' - Purpose, Images, Colors, Text, Understanding, Readability, Engagement.
- ★ Use the acronym 'A-C-T' for Audience, Creativity, and Theme.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Using too much text, making it hard to read.
- ✗ Choosing clashing colors that distract from the message.
- ✗ Ignoring the target audience, leading to irrelevant content.
