KEY CONCEPTS

Vision

A clear idea of what you want to achieve helps guide a team.

Communication

Effective leaders share ideas clearly and listen to their team members.

Empathy

Understanding others' feelings and perspectives builds trust and cooperation.

Decision-Making

Leaders must make choices that benefit the group and align with the vision.

Inspiration

Great leaders motivate others to take action and believe in the mission.

EXAMPLES

- A team captain encouraging players during a game.
- A student organizing a class project and delegating tasks.
- A club president leading meetings and making decisions.

- ★ Remember 'V-C-E-D-I' for Vision, Communication, Empathy, Decision-making, Inspiration.
- ★ Think of a famous leader and associate their traits with leadership concepts.
- ★ Use the phrase 'Lead with heart and mind' to recall the importance of empathy and decision-making.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Thinking leadership is only about authority or power.
- ✗ Neglecting to listen to team members' ideas and feedback.
- ✗ Failing to communicate the vision clearly to the group.
