What is Vocabulary

Unlocking Vocabulary: The Key to Effective Reading!

DEFINITION

Vocabulary is the set of words we know and use. It helps us understand and express ideas clearly.

KEY CONCEPTS

Word Meaning

Understanding what words mean is essential for effective communication.

Context Clues

Using surrounding words and sentences to figure out the meaning of unknown words.

Synonyms and Antonyms

Synonyms are words with similar meanings, while antonyms are words with opposite meanings.

Word Families

Groups of words that share a common root or base, helping to expand vocabulary.

Prefixes and Suffixes

Adding parts to the beginning or end of words to change their meaning or create new words.

EXAMPLES

- The word 'happy' means feeling good.
- In the sentence, 'The cat is under the table,' 'under' shows location.
- A synonym for 'big' is 'large.'

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Create flashcards with words and their meanings.
- ★ Use rhymes or songs to remember new vocabulary.
- ★ Group words by themes, like animals or emotions.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing similar-sounding words, like 'affect' and 'effect.'
- ✗ Ignoring context clues when reading.
- ✗ Not practicing new words in sentences.
