KEY CONCEPTS

Devices

Software is the programs and applications that run on devices, allowing us to perform tasks.

Internet

The Internet is a global network that connects computers, enabling communication and information sharing.

Digital Safety

Digital safety involves protecting personal information and using technology responsibly.

Basic Coding

Basic coding is writing simple instructions for computers to follow, helping us create programs.

- Setting up privacy settings on social media.
