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What is Word Meanings

DEFINITION

Word meanings tell us what a word represents or describes. Understanding them helps us communicate better.

KEY CONCEPTS

Denotation

Denotation is the literal meaning of a word, the definition you find in a dictionary.

Connotation

Connotation refers to the feelings or ideas that a word suggests beyond its literal meaning.

Synonyms

Synonyms are words that have similar meanings, helping to expand vocabulary.

Antonyms

Antonyms are words with opposite meanings, which can clarify understanding.

Context Clues

Context clues are hints within a sentence that help determine a word's meaning.

EXAMPLES

- The word 'home' denotes a place where someone lives.
- The word 'childish' has a negative connotation suggesting immaturity.
- The synonym for 'happy' is 'joyful'.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Think of denotation as 'dictionary definition'.
- ★ Use the first letter of synonyms and antonyms: S for Same, A for Against.
- ★ Create a story using new words to remember their meanings.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing denotation with connotation.
- ✗ Assuming all synonyms mean exactly the same.
- ✗ Ignoring context clues when figuring out meanings.
