DEFINITION

Creative writing is a way to express ideas and stories through imaginative language. It allows writers to explore their thoughts and feelings in unique ways.

KEY CONCEPTS

Imagination

Creative writing relies on your imagination to create new worlds and characters.

Story Structure

Good stories have a beginning, middle, and end to keep readers engaged.

Character Development

Characters should have distinct personalities and motivations to make stories relatable.

Descriptive Language

Using vivid descriptions helps readers visualize scenes and feel emotions.

Theme

The theme is the central idea or message that the writer wants to convey.

EXAMPLES

- A boy discovers a hidden door in his attic.
- A dragon befriends a lonely girl in a magical forest.
- A time traveler visits ancient Egypt and changes history.

- ★ Think of 'ICE' - Imagination, Characters, Emotions.
- ★ Use 'SCT' - Structure, Creativity, Theme to remember key elements.
- ★ Visualize a 'Story Map' to outline your ideas.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Ignoring story structure can confuse readers.
- ✗ Flat characters make stories less engaging.
- ✗ Overusing clichés can make writing feel unoriginal.
