DEFINITION

Letter formation is how we create letters correctly. It involves the shape, size, and direction of each letter.

KEY CONCEPTS

Uppercase Letters

These are the larger letters used at the beginning of sentences and names.

Lowercase Letters

These are the smaller letters used in most writing, except at the start of sentences.

Stroke Order

This is the specific way to draw each letter, which helps with neatness.

Spacing

Proper spacing between letters and words makes writing easier to read.

Consistent Size

Keeping letters the same size helps create uniform and tidy writing.

EXAMPLES

- Writing 'A' with a straight line down and a crossbar.
- Forming 'b' by starting with a straight line and adding a loop.
- Spacing between 'cat' and 'dog' in a sentence.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Think of letters as shapes; visualize them before writing.
- ★ Use songs or rhymes to remember the stroke order.
- ★ Practice with sand or finger paint for a fun tactile experience.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Mixing up uppercase and lowercase letters.
- ✗ Writing letters too close together or too far apart.
- ✗ Incorrect stroke order leading to messy letters.
