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What is Sentence Writing

Mastering Sentence Writing for Clear Communication!

DEFINITION

Sentence writing is the process of creating complete thoughts using words. A good sentence has a subject and a verb, making it easy to understand.

KEY CONCEPTS

Subject

The subject is who or what the sentence is about, usually a noun.

Verb

The verb shows the action or state of being in the sentence.

Complete Thought

A complete thought means the sentence expresses a full idea and can stand alone.

Punctuation

Punctuation marks like periods and commas help clarify the meaning of sentences.

Sentence Variety

Using different types of sentences (simple, compound) makes writing more interesting.

EXAMPLES

- The cat sleeps.
- She runs quickly.
- They are playing soccer.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'SV' for Subject-Verb to build a basic sentence.
- ★ Use 'CAPS' for Complete thoughts, Action verbs, Punctuation, and Subject.
- ★ Think of a sentence as a mini-story with a beginning (subject) and action (verb).

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Forgetting to include a subject.
- ✗ Using run-on sentences without punctuation.
- ✗ Mixing up verb tenses.
