DEFINITION

KEY CONCEPTS

Nouns

Nouns are words that name people, places, or things in Arabic.

Verbs

Verbs express actions or states of being and are crucial for forming sentences.

Adjectives

Adjectives describe nouns and help add detail to your sentences.

Pronouns

Pronouns replace nouns and make sentences less repetitive.

Common Phrases

Everyday phrases help in greetings and basic conversations.

EXAMPLES

- مَکَلِّع مَالِئِلا (As-salamu alaykum) - Peace be upon you
- بِلَا ط انا (Ana talib) - I am a student
- كِتاب (Kitaab) - Book

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Associate words with images or actions to create mental links.
- ★ Use flashcards with pictures and Arabic words for visual learning.
- ★ Group similar words together to enhance recall.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Mixing up gender forms of nouns and adjectives.
- ✗ Forgetting to use the correct verb conjugation.
- ✗ Mispronouncing Arabic letters that have unique sounds.
