MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Use the acronym 'DCPID' to remember Descriptive, Character, Plot, Imagery, Dialogue.
- ★ Visualize a story map to outline your plot structure.
- ★ Create a character profile sheet to keep track of traits and development.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to edit and revise drafts for clarity.
- ✗ Overusing clichés instead of original expressions.
- ✗ Forgetting to show rather than tell in descriptions.
