- ★ Group vocabulary by themes, like food or family, to make learning easier.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing similar-sounding words due to tone differences.
- ✗ Forgetting to include measure words when counting nouns.
- ✗ Mixing up subject and verb order in sentences.
