- ★ Practice reading aloud to improve pronunciation and fluency.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Mispronouncing Danish letters like 'ø' and 'å'.
- ✗ Confusing word order in sentences.
- ✗ Overlooking diacritics that change word meanings.
