- ★ Visualize your story like a movie scene to remember structure.
- ★ Associate character traits with familiar people to make them memorable.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to outline the story structure before writing.
- ✗ Using too many complex words instead of simple, clear language.
- ✗ Forgetting to include sensory details that enhance the narrative.
