DEFINITION

Beginner French vocabulary includes essential words and phrases for daily communication. Learning these basics helps you understand and speak the language more effectively.

KEY CONCEPTS

Common Greetings

Learn simple greetings like 'Bonjour' (Hello) and 'Au revoir' (Goodbye) to start conversations.

Numbers and Colors

Familiarize yourself with numbers (un, deux, trois) and colors (rouge, bleu) for describing things.

Food Vocabulary

Know key food words like 'pain' (bread) and 'eau' (water) for dining situations.

Family Terms

Learn family-related words such as 'mère' (mother) and 'frère' (brother) to talk about relationships.

Basic Verbs

Understand essential verbs like 'être' (to be) and 'avoir' (to have) for forming sentences.

EXAMPLES

- Bonjour, comment ça va? (Hello, how are you?)
- Je voudrais un café, s'il vous plaît. (I would like a coffee, please.)
- Mon frère s'appelle Pierre. (My brother's name is Pierre.)

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Associate colors with objects: 'rouge' for red apples.
- ★ Use rhymes: 'un' sounds like 'fun' to remember the number one.
- ★ Create flashcards with images for food words to visualize.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing 'tu' (informal you) with 'vous' (formal you).
- ✗ Mispronouncing nasal sounds like in 'pain' (bread).
- ✗ Using English word order in French sentences.
