DEFINITION

Beginner Greek vocabulary includes essential words and phrases for daily communication. Learning these helps you understand and speak Greek more effectively.

KEY CONCEPTS

Common Nouns

These are everyday objects and people, like 'book' (βιβλίο) and 'friend' (φίλος).

Useful Adjectives

Adjectives describe nouns, such as 'big' (μεγάλος) and 'small' (μικρός), enhancing your descriptions.

Numbers

Learning numbers (ένα, δύο, τρία) is essential for counting and shopping.

Basic Verbs

Verbs like 'to eat' (τρώω) and 'to go' (πάω) are crucial for forming sentences.

Simple Phrases

Phrases like 'How are you?' (Τι κάνεις;) help in everyday conversations.

EXAMPLES

- Καλημέρα (Good morning)
- Πόσο κοστίζει; (How much does it cost?)
- Είμαι καλά (I am fine)

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Associate words with images, like visualizing a book when learning 'βιβλίο'.
- ★ Use flashcards for repetitive practice of vocabulary.
- ★ Create sentences using new words to reinforce memory.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing similar-sounding words, like 'φίλος' (friend) and 'φίλη' (female friend).
- ✗ Forgetting to use the correct gender for nouns.
- ✗ Mispronouncing vowels, which can change word meanings.
