DEFINITION

KEY CONCEPTS

Nouns

Nouns are words that name people, places, things, or ideas in Hindi.

Verbs

Verbs describe actions or states of being and change according to tense in Hindi.

Adjectives

Adjectives modify nouns by describing their qualities or quantities in Hindi.

Pronouns

Pronouns replace nouns to avoid repetition and simplify sentences in Hindi.

Sentence Structure

The typical sentence structure in Hindi is Subject-Object-Verb (SOV).

EXAMPLES

→ मैं स्कूल जाता हूँ। (I go to school.)

→ वह किताब पढ़ रही है। (She reads a book.)

→ बिल्ली काली है। (The cat is black.)

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember SOV structure: Subject first, then Object, and Verb last.
- ★ Use rhymes to memorize noun and verb endings.
- ★ Visualize nouns with their corresponding adjectives to strengthen recall.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Mixing up verb tenses when conjugating.
- ✗ Forgetting to match adjectives with nouns in gender and number.
- ✗ Using incorrect pronouns for subjects.
