- ★ Create flashcards with the Icelandic word on one side and the English translation on the other.
- ★ Use rhymes or songs to memorize vocabulary, making it fun and engaging.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing similar words, like 'bók' (book) and 'bóka' (to book).
- ✗ Mispronouncing vowel sounds, which can change word meanings.
- ✗ Forgetting to use the correct gender for nouns.
