DEFINITION

KEY CONCEPTS

Greetings

Common Nouns

Everyday nouns like 'buku' (book) and 'meja' (table) are foundational for building sentences.

Basic Verbs

Verbs such as 'makan' (to eat) and 'minum' (to drink) allow you to describe actions.

Adjectives

Descriptive words like 'besar' (big) and 'kecil' (small) enhance your vocabulary.

EXAMPLES

- Selamat pagi! Apa kabar?
- Saya suka makan nasi.
- Dia membaca buku di meja.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Associate words with images (e.g., picture a big 'besar' elephant).
- ★ Use flashcards with pictures and words to reinforce memory.
- ★ Create simple sentences using new vocabulary to practice context.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing similar-sounding words (e.g., 'bisa' vs. 'bisa').
- ✗ Using incorrect verb forms in sentences.
- ✗ Neglecting to practice pronunciation, leading to misunderstandings.
