MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Use the acronym S.C.D.E. for Story Structure: Start, Create, Develop, End.
- ★ Visualize characters as friends to make them more relatable.
- ★ Think of descriptive language as painting with words.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to outline the story before writing.
- ✗ Using too many adjectives, making sentences cluttered.
- ✗ Forgetting to show character emotions through actions.
