DEFINITION

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing masculine and feminine nouns, like 'il libro' (the book) vs. 'la casa' (the house).
- ✗ Mispronouncing vowel sounds, which can change word meanings.
- ✗ Forgetting to match adjectives with nouns in gender and number.
