DEFINITION

The Persian alphabet consists of 32 letters used in the Farsi language. Learning these letters is essential for reading and writing in Persian.

KEY CONCEPTS

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing similar-looking letters like ب (Be) and پ (Pe).
- ✗ Forgetting to connect letters properly in cursive writing.
- ✗ Mispronouncing letters due to unfamiliar sounds.
