DEFINITION

KEY CONCEPTS

Common Nouns

Nouns like 'casa' (house) and 'carro' (car) are fundamental for describing objects.

Basic Verbs

Verbs such as 'ser' (to be) and 'ter' (to have) are crucial for forming sentences.

Simple Adjectives

Adjectives like 'grande' (big) and 'pequeno' (small) help describe nouns more vividly.

Question Words

Words like 'o que' (what) and 'onde' (where) are essential for asking questions.

Numbers

Learning numbers from 1 to 10 is important for counting and basic transactions.

EXAMPLES

- Eu tenho um carro. (I have a car.)
- A casa é grande. (The house is big.)
- Onde está o banheiro? (Where is the bathroom?)

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Associate words with images, like picturing a house when saying 'casa'.
- ★ Use flashcards with pictures and Portuguese words for visual learning.
- ★ Create simple sentences using new vocabulary to reinforce memory.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing 'ser' and 'estar' (both mean 'to be') in different contexts.
- ✗ Mispronouncing nasal sounds like in 'mãe' (mother).
- ✗ Forgetting to match adjectives with nouns in gender and number.
