- ★ Create rhymes or songs using vocabulary to make learning fun.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Mispronouncing letters unique to Swedish, like 'å', 'ä', and 'ö'.
- ✗ Confusing word order in simple sentences.
- ✗ Overlooking diacritics in words, which can change meanings.
