- ★ Use rhymes to remember numbers: 'One is 'Neung', two is 'Song'.
- ★ Visualize a scenario for each common phrase to strengthen recall.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Mispronouncing tones, leading to misunderstandings.
- ✗ Using formal language in casual settings.
- ✗ Neglecting to practice listening skills alongside speaking.
