- ★ Remember 'menu' starts with 'm' for 'meal'.
- ★ Think of 'bill' as a 'check' for your meal.
- ★ Use the phrase 'Can I have...' for polite requests.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Confusing 'bill' with 'menu'.
- ✗ Not using polite phrases like 'please' and 'thank you'.
- ✗ Mispronouncing food items or drink names.
